

**Theatrical premiere of "45 RPM" in Regina and Saskatoon  
Writer-Director David Schultz, star Kim Coates and Co-Producer  
Anand Ramayya  
host Gala Saskatoon opening night**

After completing its successful festival circuit, "45 RPM" is opening theatrically to the public in Saskatchewan. The feature film will open at the Regina Public Library March 19 - 22 and will play at the Broadway Theatre in Saskatoon from March 27 until April 2.

The Saskatchewan run marks a success for Saskatoon's film industry. Written and directed by Saskatoon's **David Schultz**, "45 RPM" was co-produced by Saskatoon's **Anand Ramayya** (KarmaFilm) with Calgary-based Nomadic Pictures (**Michael Frislev & Chad Oakes**) and Don Carmody Productions. Saskatoon-born **Kim Coates** stars in the film, which was set and shot in Saskatchewan.

David Schultz, Kim Coates and Anand Ramayya will be in attendance at the opening performance at the Broadway Theatre in Saskatoon on March 27.

"45 RPM" tells the story of two teenage best friends growing up in Cold War-era 1960 in the remote northern Saskatchewan town of Goose Lake. Considered outsiders by other students, they dream about leaving and when they discover the perfect spot on the roof for receiving a rock 'n roll radio signal from New York City fate seems to be at work. Evoking the magic of first discovering the music that becomes the soundtrack to pivotal phases in our lives, "45 RPM" is a coming-of-age tale about the value of friendship, the need to dream, and the challenges of real life.

Remstar Distribution and Alliance Films present "45 RPM" starring newcomers **Jordan Gavaris** and **Justine Banzsky** as the best friends, as well as **Michael Madsen** ("Reservoir Dogs"), **August Schellenberg** ("Bury My Heart at Wounded Knee"), **Amanda Plummer** ("Pulp Fiction"), **Kim Coates** ("Blackhawk Down, "CSI: Miami") and **Mackenzie Porter** ("Dinosapiens"). Written and directed by David Schultz, the executive producer is **Don Carmody** and the feature film is produced by Michael Frislev and Chad Oakes and co-produced by Anand Ramayya. The director of photography is **Craig Wroblewski** csc, the editor is **Bridget Durnford** and original music is by **Michael Neilson**.
